The symptoms of Dengue were well explained with a diagram in a convincing manner.

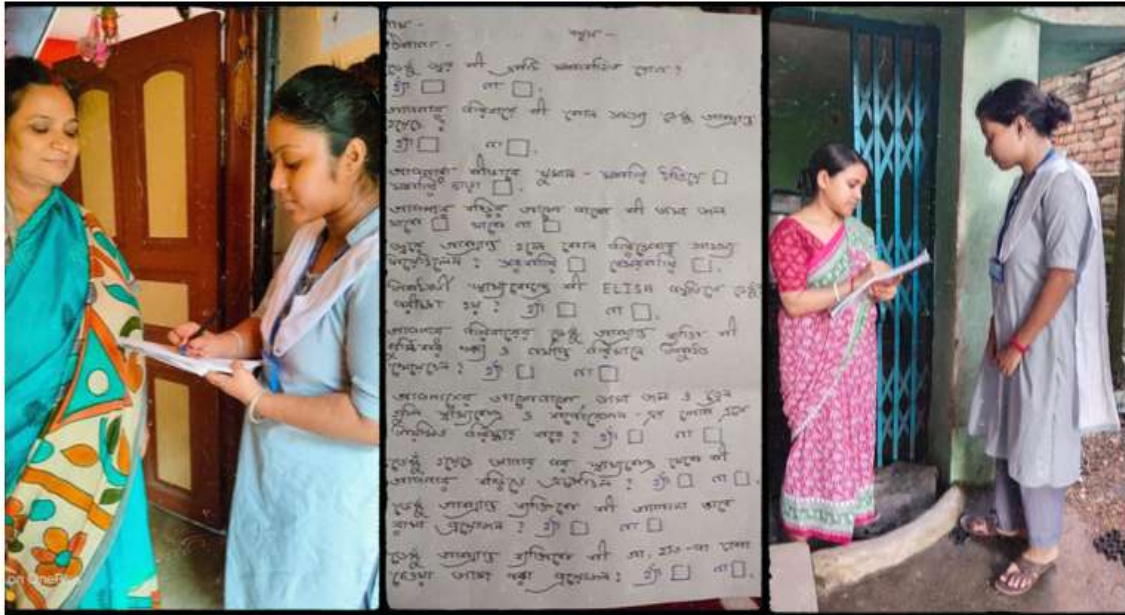


In such an alarming situation the preventive measures to stop Dengue were discussed by the trainees with the help of charts and 3D presentation prepared by themselves.
